



DALMORE 1979 CONSTELLATION

33 Years Old | Single Cask No.594

The Dalmore Constellation 1979 is an outstanding example of how time and cask selection can work together to create an exhilarating whisky. After spending 33 long years resting in Warehouse no. 9, the whisky had time to develop and refine at its own pace, yielding to an array of aromas including notes of apples, peaches and lemongrass. This whisky was aged and nurtured by a powerful cask made from Quercus Alba from the Ozark mountain range of Missouri. Each expression is housed in a spectacular hand-blown crystal decanter, engraved by hand and embellished with a solid silver stag.

Tasting notes

Color

Shimmering honeyed gold.

Aroma

Honey, peaches, nectarines and vanilla ice cream. Followed by notes of fresh apple, pear, apricots and lemongrass.

Taste

Spicy pineapple, tropical fruit salad and caramel fudge with flashes of lemon cake, frangipane, rosehip syrup and macarons. Followed by Bramley apples with peaches and cream, Turkish delight, spiced sherbet and kiwi fruits.
