One of the few examples where The Dalmore has only been matured in a single sherry cask. This whisky has been matured in a cask which has previously held rare, 30 years old Apostoles sherry. The cask has been exclusively sourced from the González Byass bodega and gifts the whisky with rich notes of orange, mango and crushed almonds.

Rich mahogany with russet highlights.

Aroma

Exciting sweet accords of creamy caramel and vanilla complete this sensual fragrance.

Taste

A whisky with depth and bold characteristic. Ripened bananas, marzipan and spicy coffee, with a tang of orange rind, pear pulp, coupled with layers of ginger spice, crushed almonds and toffee apple.

Finish

An incredible warmth of spices, great lingering caramel notes.
