Tasting notes

Aroma

Classic fruitiness with hints of apple blossom and plump pear. A perfect balance of rich vanilla oak with golden sugar and a touch of liquorice

Taste

Fruity character of a classic Glenfiddich whisky with hints of apple blossom, summer fruits and ripe pear.

Finish

Deep and mellow, the finish is long-lasting with a lingering sweet oakiness.

Glenfiddich Whisky Distillery Glenfiddich - Gaelic for Valley of the Deer - was born in the summer of 1886 when William Grant together with his seven sons and two daughters began to fulfil his lifelong dream, to produce the best whisky in the valley. Today the distillery is still run by the family and has preserved the innovative character of its founder inspired by passion and determination through five generations.
