Chartreuse Liquor D'Elixir 1605 is composed of a unique blend of 130 botanicals. Created in 2005 to celebrate the 400th anniversary of Marshal d'Estrées handing over the "Elixir de Longue Vie Manuscript" to the Chartreuse de Vauvert. The recipe is inspired by the "liqueur de santé" or "Elixir de table" dating back to the beginning of the 19th century, which became the "Chartreuse Verte" in 1840. Elixir Liqueur 1605 is presented in a bottle embossed with the symbol of the Carthusian Order, characteristic of Chartreuse liqueurs.
