Indulge in Hampden Estate's rich heritage with this exceptional 31-year-old Jamaican rum. Distilled in 1990 and bottled in Scotland in 2021, this limited-edition bottling showcases the mastery of traditional rum-making. This rare rum was drawn from single barrel #12 and bottled at a robust full proof of 55%, delivering a full flavour profile. Expect notes of tropical fruits, rich spices, hints of oak and a warming finish. With its rich provenance and limited availability of only 156 numbered bottles, this 1990 Jamaican Rum by Samaroli is a timeless treasure both for collectors and fans. The company was founded by Silvano Samaroli in 1968, who at the time was the only non-British or non-Scottish person in the trade. His passion, knowledge and experience of almost 50 years of individually selecting the best casks allowed him to expose the complexity of each of the spirits, maintaining their harmonious balance and outstanding taste. The maturation is carried out in Scotland, where the climate (cooler than in the Caribbean) enables longer ageing and consequently cleaner more elegant rums. Every bottle is numbered and dated. The company is led today by Antonio W. Bleve who after a long time of collaboration and love for the company's philosophy, has continued to deliver outstanding unique releases of single cask whiskies and rums.
