Samaroli | Cask 801901 | 2021 Release

The Ardmore distillery produced this malt whisky in 2011. Smooth and mellow, with intense and very long notes of cocoa, vanilla, straw, pear, cherry, grapefruit and caffeine. The taste is aromatic and lively, slightly smoky and rightly peaty, with a finish of liquorice, yoghurt and barley.

Supple and velvety with notes of cocoa, vanilla, straw, pear, cherry, grapefruit and finely extended caffeine.

Taste

Aromatic and tart taste, slightly smoky and peaty.

Finish

The finish shows a pleasant liquorice note, rounded off by a slightly sour yoghurt flavour and a hint of creamy barley soup.
