Despite its young age, the mastery of the woods delivers it with a delicately peaty tone. Notes of yeast, butter and smoked meat appear shyly on the nose. A bit like the scents of an extinguished fireplace after the night. Toasted tones of almond, hazelnut and candied fruit. The saline dimension surprises for its balance and harmony.

About Independent Bottler Samaroli: Samaroli is probably Italy's most renowned independent bottler, considered a visionary by most. Impeccable taste and an eye for aesthetics have given numerous of his bottlings a worthy place in the pantheon of whisky and rum giants.
