Samaroli | Cask No. 3482 | 2017 Release

An incredibly well-aged 47 year old Glen Grant single malt and from a single cask, independently bottled by Samaroli. This was distilled in Speyside all the way back in 1970 and left to mature until 2017, when it was bottled with a tiny outturn of just 112 bottles.

Rich gold in colour

Exquisite aromas of dried fruit, mint, and exotic spices.

Taste

On the palate, the whisky is superbly balanced and multi-faceted. Honey, Zero acidity, multi-faceted, saline, sweet and bitter at the same time. Olfactory hints then develop into solid, precise and well-defined sensations.

Finish

Solid and precise, with a rich finish that never ends.

About the Glen Grant Distillery The distillery is located in Rothes, Speyside. The whisky is rated as one of the best in the world and owes its success to the fact that its owners introduced the whiskey as a single malt at an exceptionally early stage. Unlike some other single malts that are denser and stronger, Glen Grant is clear, fresh and light. What sets it apart from others can be explained by the unique distillation and purification process. Slow ageing in high-quality oak barrels gives the Glen Grant its unique colour, distinctly fresh & slightly fruity taste. It is not just a matter of time. A distinctive feature of the Glen Grant Distillery is the treatment of the barrels, which are carefully hand-selected and used only a few times.
