



SAMAROLI PACIFIC OBLIVION 2009

2021 Release | Cask No.24 | Rum 12 Years Old

Samaroli presents the second edition of Pacific Oblivion - This time sourced from a single cask. This rum was distilled in 2009, aged in a single cask #24 and bottled in 2021. Samaroli describes this bottling as a true classic in their portfolio, and it is worth noting that a mere 340 bottles of this rum have been made available to the global market.

Tasting notes

Color

Classic amber tones with deep golden hues.

Aroma

Sophisticated nose with classic tones we have grown to recognise. Waxy with a hint of varnish.

Taste

Medicinal notes and dried fruits can describe this rum as peaty. The palate is infused with a sense of fire that turns to vanilla, liquorice, mint and spices like pink pepper and nutmeg.

Finish

About Samaroli: Samaroli is probably Italy's most renowned independent bottler. With his irreproachable taste for single cask whiskies and an eye for aesthetics, he is considered a visionary by most.
