A distinct whisky-ish rum from the Trinidad and Tobago archipelago. Complex and complete. Distilled in 1999 and bottled in Scotland in 2021 by independent bottler Samaroli. This is a limited edition of 267 bottles.

<u>Tasting notes</u> Aroma

Aromas of chlorophyll and molasses followed by floral notes, vanilla, liquorice and dried fruits.

Taste

In the mouth, clusters of juniper berries with an unexpected and delicate sweetness, somewhere between butter and honey. A finale where the sweet notes round off and mellow out until they break free of every form.

About Independent Bottler Samaroli: Samaroli is probably Italy's most renowned independent bottler, considered a visionary by most. Impeccable taste and an eye for aesthetics have given numerous of his bottlings a worthy place in the pantheon of whisky and rum giants. Today the production is under Antonio Bleve's direction, who has worked with Samaroli for many years and shares the passion and philosophy of the house. Antonio Bleve continues his quest for exceptional casks, relying on the brand's historical relationships and new interactions, making their latest bottlings increasingly in demand.
