



LDV | L'EAU DE VODKA

Swiss Luxury Vodka

LDV — L'Eau de Vodka — is the new Swiss luxury vodka from Swiss Spirits, Zürich. Crafted with Swiss alpine herbs and crystal-clear spring water drawn from the Alpine mountain massif, it pours silky-clean at 40% ABV in a minimalist bottle finished with a crystal-studded closure. A vodka built equally for a slow neat pour or a serious cocktail base. **DISTILLATION:** an eightfold distillation paired with a six-stage filtration through Swiss rock crystals — a process designed for maximum mildness and a flawless, neutral character. 100% produced and bottled in Switzerland, certified to the highest food-production standards. **HOW TO ENJOY:** serve straight from the freezer in a small chilled glass, or stirred over a single large ice cube to let the alpine-herb whisper come forward. Ideal in a Martini — 6 cl LDV, 1 cl La Quintinye Vermouth Royal Dry, stirred over ice, strained into a chilled coupe with a lemon twist. The silky-clean profile also holds in a Bianco-style serve — 5 cl LDV with 2 cl Antica Torino Bianco over ice, orange peel.

Tasting notes

Color

Clear and bright, with faintly golden glints that echo the maker's 'golden grain for a golden vodka' brief.

Aroma

A clean, understated nose with a delicate sweetness from fresh corn. Alcohol is well integrated, not dominant.

Taste

A silky, soft and round palate, with the typical corn cereal note and a lightly creamy texture. No harshness, no burn.

Finish

A short-to-medium finish, with measured warmth and a final trace of cereal sweetness, free of bitterness.
