A limited release, presented in an elegant dark red box and a Certificate of Authenticity. A true treat for whisky fans and connoisseurs.

Dark Amber

Aroma

Intense aromas of peat, sandalwood, citrus peel and spicy oak.

Taste

Delightful, elegant and well-balanced with layers of autumn fruits, winter spices, walnuts and a hint of sea salt, complemented by a touch of smoky peat.

Finish

Long peaty finish with tangy citrus notes.

The Bowmore Distillery Founded in 1779 by John P. Simpson. It is one of the oldest distilleries in Scotland and first in Islay, located on the southeastern shore of Loch Indaal. The distillery still has its original traditional malting floor and it is known for a variety of styles with a particular touch of peat and smoke. Today the distillery is owned by Suntory and continues producing whiskies of excellent quality.
