



REDBREAST 21 YEARS OLD

Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey

During the long ageing time, Redbreast 21 reached exceptional levels of depth and concentration of flavours, creating a complex, rewarding whiskey. It can be considered the finest representation of the signature Redbreast sherry style, rich, complex and highly aromatic. Redbreast 21 was made from a mash of malted and unmalted barley, triple distilled in copper pot stills. Matured in a combination of American bourbon barrels and first-fill Spanish oloroso sherry butts. This whiskey was produced in limited quantities

Tasting notes

Aroma

Outstanding aromas of fresh tropical fruits, nuts and rich dried fruit.

Taste

Soft vanilla, toasted oak, sweet sherry followed by a touch of spices. Luscious fleshy fruit notes complete the silky mouthfeel.

Finish

Lingering oak and spices followed by barley and dried fruit notes

About the Red Breast Whiskey Redbreast remains the pioneer of the Irish single pot still. Based on malted and unmalted barley, their whiskies reveal an intriguing complexity. Distillation takes place in three different stills then the whiskey is aged in old sherry and bourbon casks. Today, Redbreast is made at the Midleton Distillery in County Cork (alongside other great Powers, Green Spot and Jameson whiskies). Redbreast represents the very finest in Irish whiskey.
