Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey

The 27-year-old is the oldest permanent release in the Redbreast family. This bottling is composed of a blend of Pot Still whiskeys matured in bourbon, sherry and ruby port casks. Redbreast 27 Batch 2 was produced in limited quantities; each bottle is presented in an elegant wooden box, making it a great addition to a whiskey collection.

Tasting notes

Aroma

A delicious variety of exotic fruits, mango, pineapple, blood orange and ripe red berries, balanced by aromas of fresh herbs, aromatic oils and wood spices.

Taste

Ripe plums, black cherries, and a hint of spicy oak are balanced by notes of vanilla, cinnamon and toasted nuts.

Finish

A satisfyingly long balance of ripe fruit and wood spices, worthy of a journey of nearly three decades.
