Tales of The Macallan Volume II is a rare single malt whisky celebrating heritage, craft, and nature. As part of The Tales of The Macallan series, it honours visionaries who shaped The Macallan's legacy and connection to its land. This whisky was distilled in 1949 and bottled in 2022. After 73 years of maturation, this single malt offers an exceptional tasting experience of dried fruits, warm spices, and subtle oak. Encased in a bespoke, hand-crafted Lalique crystal decanter—a work of art inspired by the estate's elegance—this masterpiece combines remarkable whisky with exquisite design, making it a collector's dream and a testament to The Macallan's timeless artistry. The decanter showcases etchings of Andrew Davidson's illustrations, while the accompanying book features beautifully illustrated chapters by the artist.

Tasting notes

Aroma

Aromas of sweet woodsmoke, rich forest fruit, and leafy herbs.

Taste

Black cherries, plum jam, dark chocolate orange, almond and custard pastry.
