This is the first edition, made exclusively from American oak refill barrels. This single malt expresses the fresh, spring-like essence of The Singleton Dufftown's rather mild character. This bottle is part of the "Rare by Nature" collection, which celebrates whiskies with distinctive maturation techniques, rare finishes, and unexpected taste profiles. This year's cask strength releases, bring to life the unique character of each of the distilleries. The bottlings are all extremely rare limited editions.

Tasting notes

Color

Dry white wine, with pale yellow lights

Aroma

Mellow and mild with hardly any prickle. Honeycomb, honey and trace of beeswax. Floral note of dry grasses, fresh orchard fruits on a earthy base.

Taste

The texture is smooth and creamy, the taste is intense and mild overall, at once dry and slightly coating, with a subtle hint of beeswax reappearing.

Finish

Rather long and warming with white pepper that turns into chilli in the aftertaste. A delicate dry finish makes the palate tingle. A drop of water tames the chilli spice.
