



WILD TURKEY TRIUMPH

Master's Keep | 10 Year old Rye Whiskey

Wild Turkey Master's Keep Triumph is a 10-year-old Kentucky straight rye whiskey, bottled at 52% volume. Eddie Russell conceived the release in recognition of his son Bruce's preference for rye. At its launch, it was the oldest age-stated rye in the producer's portfolio. MATURATION: Hand-selected barrels of American oak form this small-batch release. SUGGESTIONS: Try it neat in a small tulip glass, then add a few drops of water if preferred. Alternatively, serve over a single large ice cube. A plate of aged hard cheese or unsalted pecans provides a simple accompaniment.

Tasting notes

Color

Deep amber.

Aroma

Vanilla, crème brûlée, fresh mint, baked apple, ripe pear, nutmeg.

Taste

Honey, clove, dark chocolate, dates, layered warm spice.

Finish

Soft wood, mocha, roasted oak, black pepper; long and gently warming.

WILD TURKEY DISTILLERY In Lawrenceburg, Kentucky, Wild Turkey's history encompasses both bourbon and rye. Jimmy Russell joined the distillery in 1954; Eddie followed in 1981, beginning as a relief operator before becoming a master distiller. Their careers connect the everyday work of production with the barrel selections released under the Master's Keep name.
